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Avery Fine Perfume's new store in Milan - its fourth globally - boldly flies a flag of independence when it comes to beauty products. Known for ceasing production on a fragrance the minute it becomes too popular, owner (and CEO of Intertrade Europe) Celso Fadelli has plucked a highly curated selection of niche labels for Milan, including soOud, Roads, Six Scents, Byredo Parfums, Acqua di Stresa, and Jacques Azagury. Pricey specialty products - such as Agonist's €5,000 haute couture fragrance housed in an 18-inch handblown glass sculpture or Boadicea The Victorious' rare 'Blue Sapphire' scent - mingle with candles by Fornasetti, all-natural skin care lines by llåme and Annemarie Börlind, and Jane Iredale cosmetics. The two-storey space also features an underground spa for Thai massage, manicures and facials, as well as art exhibits on the main floor curated by Fondazione Bonotto.

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
